I also hope for the further cooperation in the future.

It must be stressed we are one of very few magazines that do not charge for publications. Publishing without any charges for authors results in the fact that we do not have any budget to gratify financially reviewers for the work they do analysing the text provided. Therefore, I would like to thank you for understanding and help in efforts undertaken by us in order to popularize the research results.
